#101 Ringie Dingies - Susan Cleveland

Double points put a contemporary spin on this long time favorite. They also eliminate the need for the traditional appliqued circle in the center of each circle and allow rings to interlock! These Dresdens are built on a foundation so background fabrics don't show through and, more importantly, Dresdens turn out perfectly flat. Learn Susan's tips for speedily turning wedge points with the Prairie Pointer Tool.



#102 Sand in your Toes - Darla Parks

If you have never done Raw Edge Applique before this class is for you! You will learn the layering technique, as well as quilting with your Blanket or Decorative stitches on your machine. Also, you will learn how to use Wonder Under properly.

#103 Tumbling Triangles - Ginny Van Sice

This was a challenge to myself and I had a lot of fun adapting and creating a new design using logs around triangles. I have not seen this done before, although with quilting the saying "Everything old is new again..." so there probably are similarities to other quilts. The result can be surprising and innovative and I thoroughly enjoyed the serendipity. You cannot make a mistake here.
