

## **SUPPLY LIST FOR “MINI BLENDED FABRIC ART COLLAGES”**

As a teacher it's interesting to have students come to class who are not really interested in learning my technique. I would like to ask students to sign up for my classes if you are really wanting to learn how to do what I do. Otherwise it interferes with those who do.

Be prepared to learn and create! These workshops are a lot of fun if you have the right tools. I will bring some supplies; you will have to bring some.

Many are items you already have, or are readily available at fabric stores.

### **\$15 required supplies fee paid in class**

#### **I supply the following:**

**All fabric for the design; muslin to fuse to; Fusible web (Misty Fuse); Fabric paints; Parchment paper; Paper plate and cup**

I will have some of the tools available for purchase if students aren't able to find them: 18 mm and 28 mm rotary cutters, craft knife like X-Acto, small scissors, large tweezers, paintbrushes, fabric paint sets, permanent glue

#### **STUDENTS SHOULD BRING:**

Large tweezers like beading tweezers

Parchment paper or Teflon ironing sheet

Small Elmer's Glue

Rotary cutter (28 mm is a very functional size) and cutting mat at least 12" X 12" or larger

Small angular paintbrushes for detail painting: 1/2" angular, 1/4" angular, 1/8" angular, 0 liner. (Brushes will be available for purchase in class if preferred. I do not loan brushes.)

Waste sack (this is a very messy technique!)

Ziploc bag in which to take leftovers home
