

Hawaiian Quilting 101  
With Vicky Fleming  
And Jane Schurr

CLASS SUPPLY LIST



Three free designs will be available for you to choose one from: 'Ulu, Ti Leaf or Orchid. These patterns are among those found in *Hawaiian Applique* by Vicky Fleming. Jane will have some freezer paper available if you have trouble finding it.

To make a 20" block you will need:

1. 20" square 100% cotton solid color fabric for the design.
2. 20" square 100% cotton solid color fabric for the background.
3. 22" square 100% cotton solid color fabric for the backing
4. 22" square wool or polyester mid- or lightweight batting
5. 4 strips 2"x22" for binding
6. 9"x20" fabric for sleeve – match backing fabric
7. 20" square freezer paper
8. Paper scissors
9. Sharp 8" fabric scissors
10. Straight pins
11. Stapler
12. Thread to match your design fabric
13. White thread for basting
14. Applique Needle
15. Basting Needle
16. Pencil or similar marking tool
17. 4 strips 4"x28" pre-quilted fabric\*
18. 14", 16" or 18" quilting hoop\*

\*You won't need these for the class, but you will want them to finish the quilting.

A note or two about fabric choices:

Traditionally, solid colors or solid-looking colors are used, and black is considered an unlucky color. Some modern designers use batiks on solid.

You may choose to put a dark color design on a light background or a light colored design on a dark background. The binding should be the darker fabric either way.

One more thing – If you prefer to make this into a pillow, you'll need an additional 20" square of fabric for the back of the pillow; more if you intend to use a zipper.
