

Supply List - Quilt As You Go Class Thursday April 4 2019 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. at Faith Lutheran Church

The sample quilt is approximately 42" x 52", each square is 10 ½" and there are 20 squares per quilt (4 x 5). The materials listed is for making this size quilt BUT...you can really make the squares any size you want and you can make as many squares as you want.

Before class, cut the following:

- 20 – 11" squares of batting
 - *You can use any batting that is not real thick or not real thin and has mostly cotton because of the ironing. Or even a fusible batting.*
- 20 – 12" Focus fabric squares; 10 squares for the front and 10 squares for the back
 - *In the class sample I used different but coordinating focus fabrics on each side. I had 3 different 'beach sandy' fabric on front and 2 different 'fishy' fabrics on back because this is what I had in my stash. In the past I've made the sides different colors but you could also do one side Christmas and the other side Easter.*
- A **bunch** of coordinating fabric strips 1 ½" – 3" wide (if you are doing the same size block as the class sample, otherwise you can use skinnier strips)



Other Materials

- Sashing fabric – you will need about ½ yard of fabric for each side. We will cut this in class.
- Thread to match or compliment your focus fabric. This thread will be used in the bobbin and will show on the reverse side focus fabric so pick something that works well.

Supplies

- Sewing machine with zig-zag capability
- Walking foot
- Extra Fine Sharpie Black or Brown Marker
- A 10 ½" square ruler IF you have one, or a 12 ½" Square Ruler
- Ruler long enough to draw a diagonal line on the batting squares
- Rotary Cutter and Mat
- Scissors
- The usual sewing supplies
