

PRQG Basic Skills Class #4: Binding a Quilt

What You Will Need:

- * your sandwiched, quilt with quilting completed (**NOTE:** If you did not get this far, don't fret! In class I will have plenty of placemats for you to learn how to bind. These placemats will be going to food pantry recipients (or you can keep what you make as a sample).
- * ½ yard fabric for your binding (for those who will be binding your quilt; I will have fabric for the placemats)
- * thread to match your binding fabric (**NOTE:** If binding placemats, you will need red and green thread...think Christmas colors.)
- * thread to match your border fabric
- * thread to match your backing fabric
- * Clover clips or binding clips (I will have some for you to borrow and use if you don't have these. Clover clips or knock-offs work best.)
- * rotary cutter
- * cutting mat if you like your own better than the guild's; bigger is better
- * your favorite ruler(s) to use when cutting strips of fabric
- * fabric marking utensil (e.g. Frixion pen, chalk marker, disappearing ink fabric marker, even a pencil will do!)
- * sewing machine with cords
- * walking foot for your machine (really, really recommended)
- * any other favorite item you use when sewing (seam ripper!!!!!!)
