

Spring Challenge 2022

The theme for our next Spring Challenge, to be revealed in March 2022, will be “My Favorite Things”. (Yes! Inspired by the song.)

Once again, it will be a donation quilt to the guild. However, with the near proximity to the Quilt Show in 2023, you may choose to donate your quilt to either Community Quilts or to the Boutique at the Quilt Show. Community Quilts run from 36 X 42 for Head Start to very large for Habitat. Boutique will accept any of these sizes as well.

Choose one or more of your Favorite Things and represent them in your quilt. You can choose your favorite color, your favorite fabrics, your favorite activity, your favorite person, your favorite pet or animal, your favorite beverage, or any thing that makes you smile.

Here are some examples –

Your favorite color – make a quilt using only shades of that color. Or one shade with either white or black as a contrast.

Your favorite song – use fabrics that represent the instruments playing that song; applique different elements of the song or the instruments; create a feeling through pattern and color of how the song makes you feel; etc.

Personally – I love to sew. So I could use fabrics that represent sewing tools such as patterns, thread, measuring tapes, scissors. I could also find a pattern to applique or paper piece these elements. My favorite way to demonstrate my favorite pastime would to piece together a quilt using all the scraps from past projects. Each element would be a reminder of something I had previously made that I enjoyed making and sharing.

I hope that you feel inspired to join in the challenge and share with us all your Favorite Things.
