The Miniature Quilt Group invites you to participate in our first Challenge!

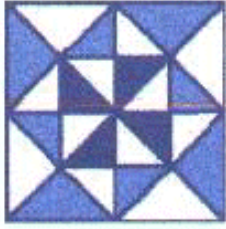

I'm not sure how long this will take, if you get hungry at noon, you may want to bring a lunch.

Preparation:

- Small quilt sandwich - front, batting, and back already put together at least 15" square or a rectangle
- If you want to make a finished project to keep, you can do a small landscape type background, and **quilt it before class.**
- If doing just a sample, bring a quilt sandwich about 15" sq.

Fabrics:

Fabrics with good color on each side, no white on back, batiks work well. Use leftover strips, scraps which you can cut into strips

Bring to class:

- Scissors
 - Small pins
 - Glue stick
 - Rotary cutter, small mat, ruler (optional, can cut strips with scissors)
 - .Various shades of tans to darks browns, blacks, grays, autumn colors, whatever you might put in a tree trunk.
 - Cut fabric into strips from 1/4" to 1 1/2" wide by any length, but at least 18". (can cut these in class with scissors.)
