

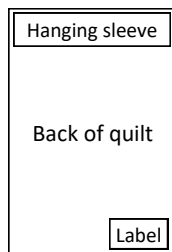

Peace River Quilt Festival 2019

RULES FOR ENTRY

1. Entrant (quilt maker) must be a member of Peace River Quilters' Guild (PRQG) by Sept. 1, 2018, AND pay annual renewal dues by Jan. 31, 2019.
2. Entrant may enter up to 3 quilted items.
3. Entry quilt may not have been previously shown in ANY Florida quilt show.
4. Entry must be constructed ONLY by entrant.
Exceptions: Collaborative Quilts, Vintage UFO Quilts.
5. Entries made from kits are acceptable ONLY in Art Quilts (non-original), Wearables & Accessories, and Professional Collaborative Quilts.
KIT: a package of specific fabrics, plus pattern, and directions for completion, pre-selected by a designer or quilt shop, OR purchased individually by entrant to match pattern cover. At least 75% of fabric must be different from fabric or colors suggested by designer to NOT be considered a kit.
6. Entry must have 3 layers: fabric top, batting and backing or lining. Entry must have a finished edge.
Exception: batting usually not used in some examples in Other Quilting Techniques category.
7. Entry must have some quilting visible on the back.
8. Items framed in metal or wood will not be accepted.
9. Entry must have a fabric label with entrant's name and quilt name. Look at the BACK of your quilt. Securely attach the label in the LOWER RIGHT corner.
Wearables & Accessories: attach label wherever practical.
10. A thread-basted piece of opaque fabric must cover the label. Use large basting stitches so it can be easily removed after judging. Fabric piece will not be returned.
11. Entry must have a 4" hanging sleeve properly attached to the back, at the top, AND no higher than 96" from the bottom edge of the quilt. (*Directions available on PRQG website.*)
12. Miniatures and quilts with a perimeter of 100" or less must have a 2" or larger hanging sleeve properly attached to the back, at the top. (*Directions available on PRQG website.*)
13. Every entry must be registered, including Special Exhibit entries.
14. Registration Form must be completely filled out for EACH entry. Print a photo of the COMPLETED quilt on the back of the form. Or, securely attach a photo to the back of the form with entrant's name and phone number. Photos will not be returned.
15. Postmark deadline for Registration Form with photo of COMPLETED quilt is Dec. 31, 2018.
16. If entry is to be offered for sale, a completed Quilt for Sale Form must accompany the Registration Form. (*Quilt For Sale form available on PRQG website*)
17. Show Committee reserves the right to change the category of any entry if necessary. Every effort will be made to consult with the entrant on this decision.
18. Entries must be delivered to Faith Lutheran Church on Sun., Feb. 17, 2019 from 12:00-3:00 pm.
19. Entries MUST be clean AND free of odors, pet hair and loose threads.
20. Take-in staff will not be responsible for attaching hanging sleeves or label covers.
21. After check-in and inspection, you will receive a receipt for each entry. Keep receipts in a safe place!
22. Entries must be picked up at Charlotte Harbor Event Center, Sat., Feb. 23, 2019 from 4:30-5:30 pm. Receipts must be submitted to claim your quilts.
23. If someone else is picking up your quilts, fill out and sign your receipts, giving permission for that person to claim them.
24. Entries will be insured for the replacement value only.
25. Certified Quilt Appraiser Alma Moates will be available during Show hours. To have a quilt appraised, submit a Quilt Appraisal Form and payment to Becky Marsteller by Jan. 31, 2019. See form for fees and details (*Quilt Appraisal Form available on PRQG website*).

CATEGORIES

After Registration closes categories may be broken down into manageable groups for judging.

ART QUILTS:

NON-ORIGINAL design and/or construction technique. Includes pictorials and landscapes. Entry must utilize fabric, batting and backing. Some quilting must be visible on back. Kits are acceptable. Any size.

ART QUILTS:

Unique quilts using an ORIGINAL design and/or construction technique. Includes pictorials and landscapes. Entry must utilize fabric, batting and backing. Some quilting must be visible on back. Any size.

APPLIQUÉ QUILTS:

Predominantly appliquéd design. Any size.

PIECED QUILTS:

Predominately pieced design. Any size.

MIXED TECHNIQUE QUILTS:

Roughly equal parts appliquéd and pieced construction. Any size.

SCRAP QUILTS:

Must use 50 or more different fabrics, excluding change of color in same fabric design. Any technique. Any size.

NEW! VINTAGE UFO QUILTS:

Quilt blocks or tops started by someone outside PRQG, then finished AND quilted by entrant. Any technique. Any Size.
Example: UFOs found in grandma's attic or at a yard sale. Must have been a UFO, not just a collection of fabrics or scraps.

EMBROIDERED QUILTS:

Predominantly machine and/or hand embroidered. Some quilting must be visible on back. Original design optional. Quilting must be by entrant ONLY. Any size.

MINIATURE QUILTS:

All aspects are in reduced scale. Must have a 2" or larger hanging sleeve properly attached to the back, at the top. Any technique. Total perimeter 96" or less.

ROOKIE QUILTS:

Entrant has never entered a quilt in ANY quilt show. Completely made AND quilted by entrant. One quilt per entrant. Any technique. Any size.

COLLABORATIVE QUILTS:

Quilts worked on by 2 or more members of PRQG only. Includes Round Robins. No money exchanged. Any technique. Any size. *(If awarded, only 1 ribbon will be provided per quilt.)*

PROFESSIONAL COLLABORATIVE QUILTS:

Money exchanged for a kit and/or quilting. Quilt top must be made completely by entrant. Any technique. Any size.

QUILTED WEARABLES & ACCESSORIES:

Articles of clothing, totes, or purses. Any technique. Must be quilted. Kits are acceptable. MUST have 3 layers: fabric top, batting/interfacing, and backing/lining. Only the lining does not need to be quilted.

OTHER QUILTING TECHNIQUES:

Examples: cathedral window, crazy quilt, English folded, tied, whole cloth, yo-yo. Quilting, if applicable, must be by entrant ONLY. Any size.

SPECIAL EXHIBIT: "Celebrate the Land That I Love"

Rules and focus fabric will be provided at sign-up.

SPECIAL EXHIBIT: "Memorial Quilts"

Made by Guild members who passed away since our 2017 Show. Not judged.

CATEGORY AWARDS:

ONLY at the judge's discretion will 1st, 2nd, 3rd and/or Honorable Mention ribbons be awarded.

EXCELLENCE AWARDS:

Kits not eligible.

All aspects of entry must be completed by PRQG member(s). Entrant must have made at least 1 Community Quilt in 2018.

- ◆ Best of Show
- ◆ Best Use of Classic Pattern
- ◆ Best Use of Color & Design
- ◆ Best Use of Embellishments
- ◆ Best Hand Quilting (*predominantly*)
- ◆ Best Stationary Machine Quilting (*predominantly*)
- ◆ Best Track-Mounted Machine Quilting (*predominantly*)



CHOICE AWARDS:

All entries are eligible for these two awards.
