Tips and Tricks for Making T-Shirt Quilts with Jane Haworth. Class 201

In this class students will learn the best way to design a quilt with T-shirts, sweatshirts, or other textile items they have available. Every quilt design will be unique and different! A variety of designs and design options will be shared so your quilt won't look like the typical block and sashing style you see most often. Cutting the logos different sizes and combining a variety of fabrics will give that one of a kind style. Although the quilt won't get finished during the class students will get it mapped out, cut and blocks started before continuing at home.

After this class, you will be able to tackle any Bargello project. I will cover the basics and you will be able to finish a 48"x48" top during the retreat. You might even have time to add a border. If you wanted to make a bed sized quilt, you can put four of these together. Jelly roll friendly.



Having Fun with Circles with Holly Watson. Class 203

In this class we will learn how to cut and sew circles and layer circles to create your own one of a kind creative wall-hanging. With the cutouts from our first project, you can create another small project. First, we will practice cutting and sewing circles, layering circles, and maybe piecing rings. After the above learning exercises, you will start designing and creating your project.

Thread Painting Sampler Class with Keet Hornbuckle. Class 204

This class will practice different stitches in thread painting. Learn to thread paint a flower on a piece of flower fabric, learn to thread paint lace flowers with tulle. We will also learn to stitch on 2 layers of water soluble stabilizer to form a flower. This flower will be completely free standing.
