Peace River Quilt Festival 2027

RULES FOR ENTRY

Show Committee reserves the right to refuse an entry if it does not comply with any Rule.

1. Entrant (quilt maker) must be a member of Peace River Quilters' Guild (PRQG) prior to Sept. 1, 2026, and pay annual renewal dues by Jan. 31, 2027.
2. Entrant may enter up to 3 quilted items plus one (1) quilt for the Show Challenge; "Songs of the 80's".
3. Entrant must have turned in at least one (1) Community Quilt in both 2025 and 2026. Members joining after Sept 1, 2025 need only complete one quilt.
4. Entry quilt may not have been previously shown in ANY quilt show.
5. Entry must be constructed and quilted ONLY by the entrant.
* Exceptions: Duet, Non-Guild Duet, and Collaborative Quilts.

Duet - Quilt top made by entrant and quilted for pay by another PRQG member (**money exchanged**)

Non-Guild Duet - Quilt top made by entrant and quilted for pay by a Non-PRQG member (**money exchanged**) or Quilt top is a **REPLICA** of the pattern cover or pattern designer suggestions. *See Rule 6 for REPLICA definition

Collaborative - quilt made and quilted by members of PRQG with **no money exchanged**
6. **REPLICA RULE:** A REPLICA is using the exact fabrics as pictured on the pattern cover **OR** the suggestions in the pattern from the pattern designer. At least **75% of all fabrics** must be different from the pattern cover fabrics or suggested by the designer to NOT be considered a Replica.
*Replicas are accepted ONLY in Art Quilts: Non-Original and Non-Guild Duet Categories.
7. **QUILT DEFINITION:** Must have 3 layers: fabric top, batting, and backing or lining. Must have a finished edge. *
Exception: Batting usually is not used in some examples of quilts in the Non-Traditional Quilts category.
8. **QUILTING:** Entry must have quilting visible on the back.
9. Wood/metal frames or hangers are not allowed.
10. **LABEL:** Entry must have a fabric label with entrant's name and quilt name. Look at the BACK of your quilt. Securely attach the label in the LOWER RIGHT corner. Labels need not be covered.

11. **HANGING SLEEVE:** Entry must have a 4" hanging sleeve securely attached to the back, at the top, AND no higher than 96" from the bottom edge of the quilt.
*Directions for hanging sleeve are available on PRQG website.

Show Committee reserves the right to: • refuse an entry if it does not comply with any Rule. • change the category of any entry in the best interest of the entrant.

Every effort will be made to limit judging groups to 15 quilts per group, giving you a 1 in 5 chance of winning a ribbon.
