Heidi introduces you to the timeless art of mosaic designreimagined from ceramic tile into fabric—through her unique, step-by-step techniques. You'll discover not just how to construct a mosaic quilt, but how to design and think like a mosaic artist:

Design a mosaic the traditional way—exploring layout, balance, and the ancient Roman approach to flow and direction (andamento).

Understand mosaic shapes—from squares and rectangles to more organic tesserae—and how their placement can echo the look of stone mosaics in fabric. Recognize fabric values and color placement to build depth, light, and shadow, much like traditional mosaics used shading to bring a design to life. Experiment with both traditional and innovative cutting methods to achieve organic shapes and clean, precise mosaic pieces.



#202 Moon Dance or Moon Dance Revival - Nancy Reester

Moon Dance and it's smaller version, Moon Dance Revival, are a challenging quilt pattern offered for the experience quilter. You'll learn three techniques using the QRC Ruler with the pattern that will make those moons go together perfectly. You'll achieve a good beginning to your quilt and have all the techniques you need to finish. The pattern and ruler are required to make this quilt. Moon Dance is 64" x 80". #203 Sewing Machine Feet Organizer - Maureen Shaffer

Keep all your sewing machine feet in one place with this hanging organizer. With this organizer, your feet are all visible and easy to find. Folds compactly to take all your feet with you in a small package.





#204 Reading Pillows - Judy Whittaker

In this workshop, you will be making at least two reading pillows. For the first pillow, you will be provided with a pre-quilted & embroidered pocket along with all other sections of the pillow pre-cut. If you wish to keep the reading pillow (minus the insert), there will be a \$20 fee. However, if you want to donate the finished pillow cover to the 2027 quilt show boutique, there is no fee!

For the second pillow, you will be using your own fabric to create a strip-pieced pocket. You will be using your machine's built-in stitches to quilt this pocket. (Even a straight stitch will work!) You may have time to make more than one of these reading pillows!
